Extended Common-Use Gate Hours Begin Aug. 2

July 26, 2010

The SCSPA is extending its common-use gate hours due to an increase in container volume through the Port of Charleston. As of Monday, August 2, 2010, North Charleston Terminal and Wando Welch Terminal common-use container gates will be extended one hour, remaining open until 1800 (6 p.m.) instead of 1700.

The new common-use gate hours will be 0700-1800 with no closure for lunch, Monday-Friday. Cut-off times will be 1730 for single missions and 1700 for dual missions and reefers.

The Columbus Street Terminal common-use gates will not be revised. Operating hours will continue to be 0800-1200 and 1300-1700 with a one-hour closure for lunch. Cut-off times at Columbus Street will remain 1630 for single missions and 1600 for dual missions and reefers.

Common-use gates are those operated by the SCSPA.

Maersk/APM, Evergreen/Ceres, and CKYH/Ceres operate their own gates and are not affected by this announcement.
